**WHY DID JESUS PERFORM MIRACLES?
JESUS PERFORMED MIRACLES TO GLORIFY GOD, TO SHOW HE IS THE
SON OF GOD, AND TO CARE FOR PEOPLE.**

Jesus woke up very early the next morning. He found a quiet place to pray to God His Father. Jesus' disciples searched for Him. When they finally found Him, they said, "Everyone is looking for You!"

But Jesus said, "Let's go on to other villages so that I can share the good news about the kingdom of God there, too. This is why I have come."

Then a man with a skin disease called leprosy came to Him. The man fell on his knees before Jesus and begged Him, saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean."

He reached out His hand and touched the man, saying, "I am willing. Be made clean." Immediately, the man's skin was healed.

Jesus said, "Don't say anything to anyone, but go and show yourself to the priest and make an offering to God." But the man couldn't keep the good news to himself.

Jesus stayed in deserted places, and people came from all over Galilee to hear Him preach and to be healed. But Jesus often left the crowds so He could pray to God.

Christ Connection: Jesus was willing to heal the man's skin and make him clean. Jesus is also willing save those who humble themselves, repent of their sin, and trust in Him.
