Jesus passed by a man named Levi, who was a tax collector. Jesus said, "Follow Me." Levi got up and followed Jesus.

Jesus went to Levi's house. The religious leaders came to Jesus' disciples and said, "Why does Jesus eat with tax collectors and sinners?"
