# JESUS' FIRST MIRACLE

John 2

**DID JESUS EVER SIN?  
NO, JESUS NEVER SINNED.**

Jesus, His mother Mary, and His disciples were invited to a wedding. When the wine ran out, Jesus' mother told Him, "They don't have any wine."

Mary told the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

Six stone water jars were at the wedding. Jesus told the servants to fill the jars with water. Then Jesus said, "Now draw some water out and give it to headwaiter." The servants did as Jesus said.

The water had been turned into wine. The headwaiter called the groom and said, "You have kept this amazing wine until the end!"

This was the first miracle Jesus performed.
