
What is Satan like?

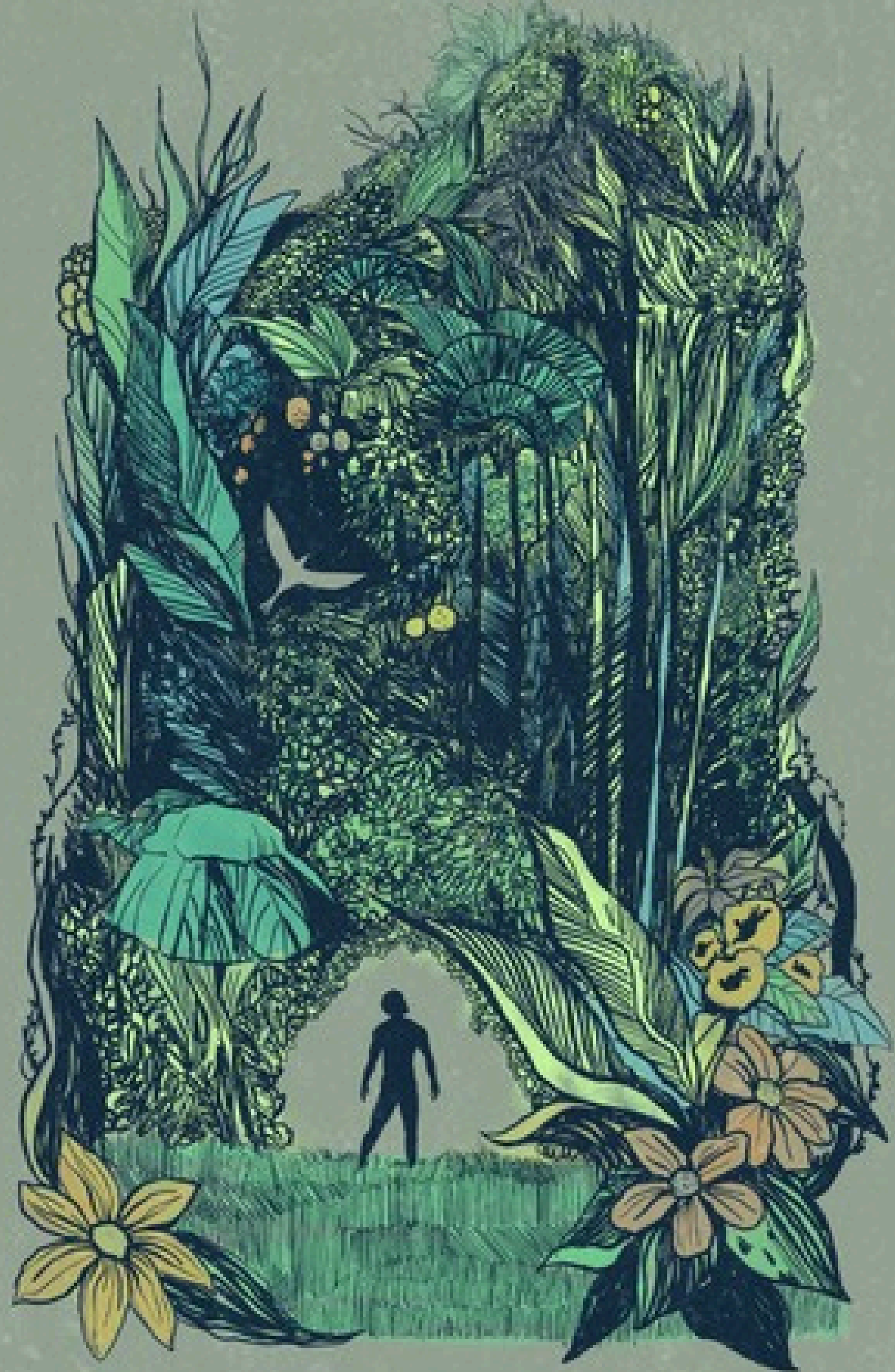

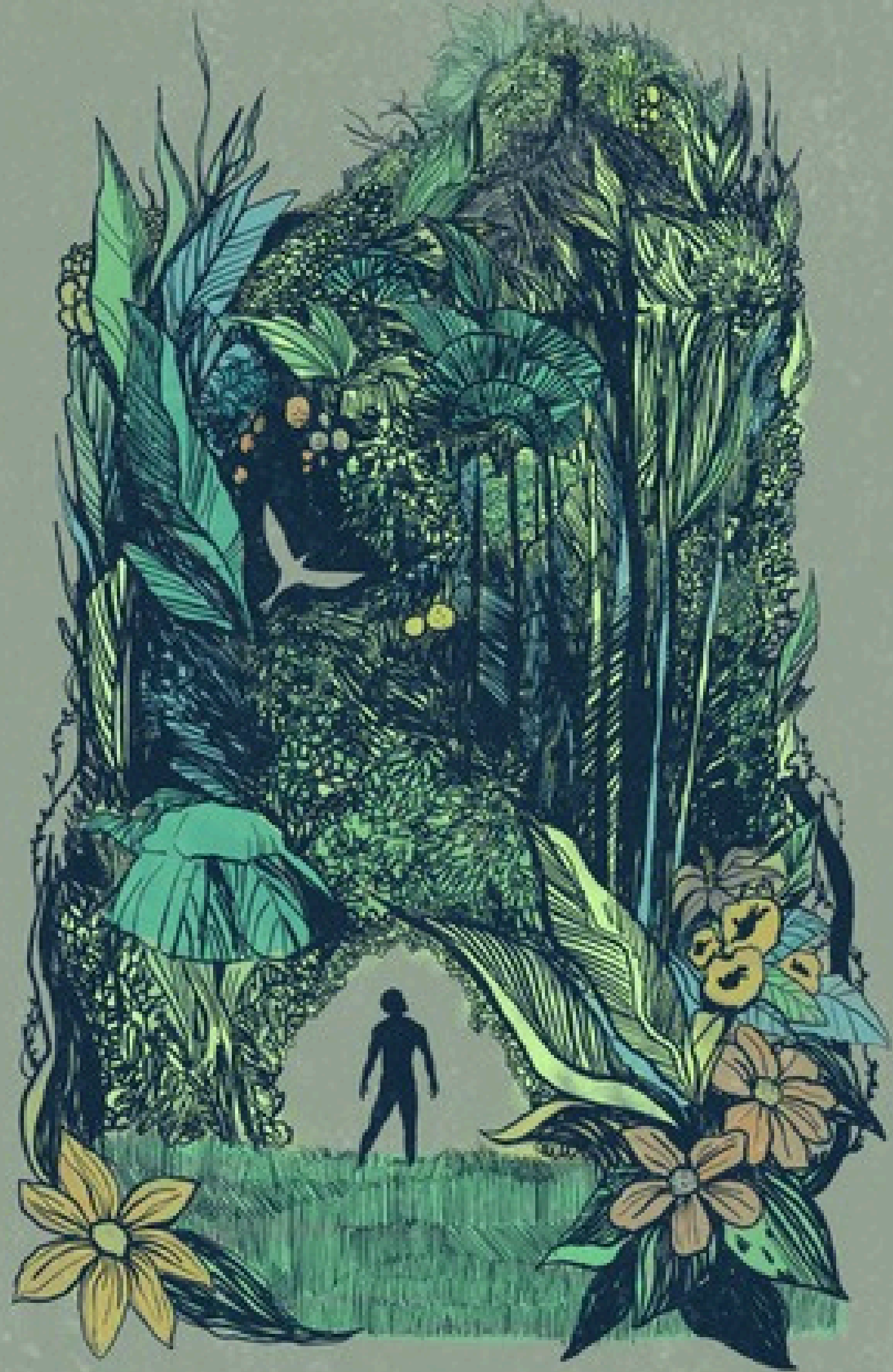
